Clothing & Book Swap FAQ

Q: How does it work?

A: Donate as many gently used items as you want on Saturday, May 22nd from 8am - 2pm behind Hinesburg Town Hall under the covered ramp. Items will not be accepted during the swap. There will also be a collection box for donations on the front porch of Town Hall from May 17th - 21st. Volunteers will sort clothing by size and gender. We don't assign dollar values or tally up what you drop off. Participants in the swap can pick whatever they need for their families on Saturday, May 22nd from 4 - 5:30pm.

Q: What health and safety precautions are you taking?

A: This swap will occur outside behind Town Hall. Tables will be placed more than 6 feet apart and masks will be required.

Q: Do I need to drop off clothing and/or books to participate?

A: No! If you just need clothing for your family and do not have anything to donate, you are welcome to just "shop."

Q: Can I drop off toys?

A: We do not accept toys. Please consider donating those elsewhere.

Q: What if it rains?

A: In case of inclement weather the rain date will be Sunday, May 23rd from 4 - 5:30pm.
